PURPOSE

This Circular is intended to invite the Heads of Supply Chain Management (SCM) and Managers for Information Technology in Departments and Public Entities listed in Schedule 3A and 3C to the Public Finance Management Act, (1999) (Act No.1 of 1999) to an awareness session about the implementation of the National Treasury's National Mobile Communications Project.

BACKGROUND

In terms of Section 38 (1) (a) (iii) and 51 (1) (iii) of the PFMA, the accounting officer of a department or constitutional institution and the accounting authority of a public entity listed in Schedule 3A and 3C to the PFMA must ensure that their respective institution has and maintains an appropriate procurement and provisioning system which is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost effective.

The South African Government spends close to R 3,2 billion per annum on fixed line and mobile communication services for national and provincial departments alone. As a result National Treasury has developed a national sourcing strategy for the procurement of mobile communications to avoid further duplication of effort and high state expenditure in mobile communication.

DISCUSSION

National Treasury will be conducting an awareness session in the Province, in preparation of the roll-out and implementation of the Mobile Communication Services. The purpose of the session will be to unpack the Communication Services for ease of understanding and the implementation process on submission of participation letters to the RT 15 - 2016.


